

Helpful Hints to Maximize your Prescription Benefits:

- Try using generics wherever possible, they minimize your out-of-pocket costs and help stabilize insurance rates for your group.
- If your insurance has a preferred pharmacy, use it for additional savings.
- If you have DAW (Dispense as Written) prescriptions, ask your doctor if you have to continue with the brand if a generic is available. DAW prescriptions will cost substantially more when there is a generic available.
- Try mail ordering your prescriptions. Medco by mail has convenient home delivery and you save by allowing you to pay 2 co pays for a 90 day supply.
