**Students who tutor must have an overall G.P.A. of 3.0 and a 3.0 G.P.A. in the subjects they wish to tutor.**

You may submit a recommendation anytime during the semester. We will contact the recommended students, explain our tutor selection process and invite them to schedule a job interview.
